### Dahl (Class 2)



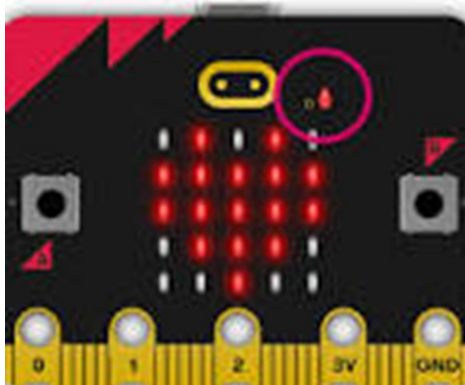
This week in Dahl Class, we have continued our learning in Topic and learned about climates of the world. We learned about the northern and southern hemisphere and learned the key vocabulary; cold, warm, tropical and temperate. Also, some of us have written letters to a Year 2 class at a school in Malawi, Africa and hopefully we will get a reply in the next few weeks!! We have asked them all about their life living in Africa so hopefully we will find out more. In Science, we learned about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and considered how different animals find food in their habitats. Well done everyone!

### Suess (Class 3)

This week in Suess, we have been extremely busy getting ready for our Class 3 Assembly. We really enjoyed telling you some of the amazing things we have been learning about. We have also made the most of this beautiful weather, going outside for Maths to look at length and perimeter. We have looked at millimetres, centimetres, meters and kilometres. In Science, we have experimented with different drinks and the impact these have on our teeth and how best we can look after them. In French we have been learning how to say where we live, our address and whether we live in the country in a house or a flat in a town. Then, we have also looked at mummification in our new English reading book 'Mummies Unwrapped' by Tom Froese. Finally, we have completed our Art masterpieces on pixelated art. ### Morpurgo (Class 4)



This week, Morpurgo class have completed their programming unit in Computing. We created, tested and debugged our own programmes using the Microbits. Some of us programmed music, some of us planned a series of symbols and some of us spelt out whole words using our coding skills. In French, we learned the vocabulary for different places in our village and used this to write sentences saying why we like/dislike where we live. Finally, in English, we have been using relative clauses and direct speech to write some twisted fairy tale stories.

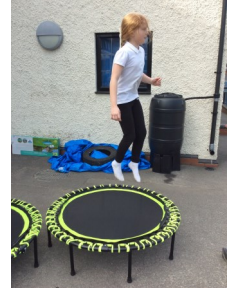
## Laugh 'n' Learn Preschool

Preschool have begun the new maths topic 'Compare and Sort collections' and have begun explore making collections with small and then large objects, develop the understanding that some objects take up more space than others and use the comparative language of 'fewer', 'more' or 'the same' to make comparisons. In phonics, we have worked on talking about the difference in sounds that we hear and make through alliteration and the different sounds we can make with our voice. We have loved printing with patterns on the creative table and playing in our role play as 'vets' with the medical kits!
